Animal Adoption Policies & Statements

- Applicant is 18 years of age, or older, and able to provide identification showing date of birth and current address.
- Applicant has the knowledge and consent of all adults residing at the residence where the animal(s) will be housed.
- Applicant, who does not own the property, is able to provide proof of pet deposit and lease agreement verifying that pets will be allowed by property owner/manager.
- Applicant will be solely responsible and liable for the actions of the dog after he/she takes possession.
- Applicant is able, and willing, to provide the time, and responsible care, for the foster animal(s).
- Applicant understands that approval may be subject to a home inspection by the Director, or designated representative of *Furr Ever Pets Rescue*.

If adoption is approved, applicant agrees to commit to provide the adopted animal(s) with love, attention, and care, on a daily basis. He/she is willing to put in the time/effort to ensure their new pet has the highest possible chance of being a happy, healthy, well-balanced pet (i.e. house-training, crate-training, leash-training, working with basic behavioral issues).

I, the undersigned adopter, understand and agree with the following statements:

- The information provided is true, and correct, to the best of my knowledge, and may be verified prior to the approval of this adoption.
- *Furr Ever Pets Rescue* reserves the right to deny any adoption, based on the information given, if it has been determined to be in the best interest of the dog(s).
- *Furr Ever Pets Rescue* reserves the right to request the return of the dog(s) if it has been determined that the dog(s) is not being properly taken care of or the given information was falsified. All in the best interest of the dog(s).
- Dogs will be refunded when returned **within 72 hours** but a \$30 fee will be charged. While no refunds will be given after 72 hours, *Furr Ever Pets Rescue* is willing to take back the dog at any time if the adopter is unable to keep him/her due to any circumstances. Under no circumstances is the dog to be sold, leased, or given away to a pet store, laboratory, research facility or animal shelter. Nor given to another person without the permission of the *Furr Ever Pets Rescue*.
